- ▶ Mitigate any disruptions to teaching

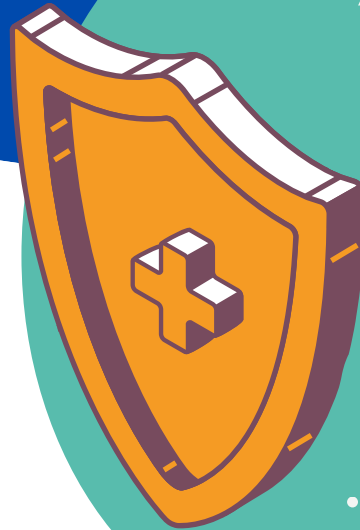
